### Remembrance Day

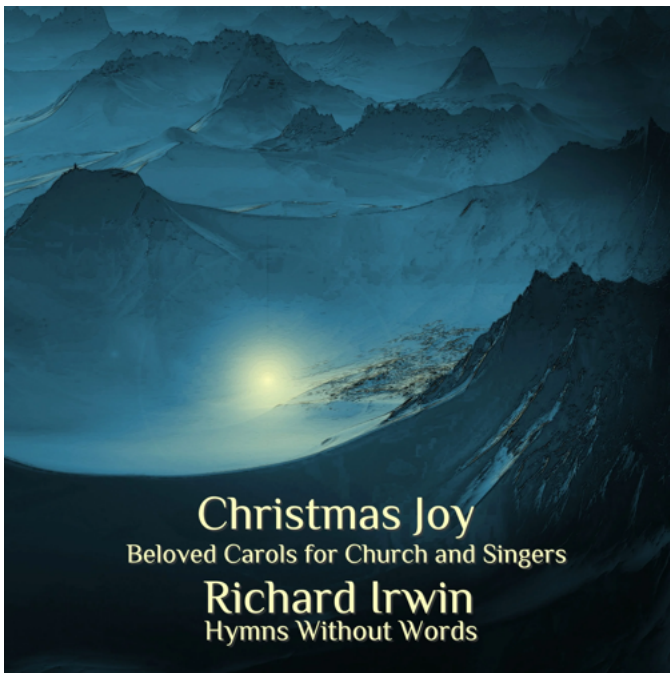
As we approach Remembrance Day and remember all those who have sacrificed their lives in conflict, here are some pieces suitable for marking this occasion, including a recording of The Last Post.
